

## Pastor's Letter Notas del Pastor



Dear Parishioners and Friends of Ascension,

Our mission this year to El Factor in Nagua, was in large part organized by Marisol Reyes and Jonathan Casilla. They did a superb job. Thank you both!

We returned for a third year to the community of El Factor, outside Nagua, on the DR's north coast. On a mission, we serve according to the needs and the wishes of the host parish. This was a wonderful mission, all went well and we, along with the parish of San Francisco, placed a strong emphasis on Pope Francis' encyclical, Laudato Si. On Monday, July 6th, we went to a small community and we helped with a cleaning campaign. We picked up and bagged garbage, particularly things like plastic bags, that would be harmful to what would otherwise be fertile soil. On Tuesday, we were divided up into four groups, and between Tuesday and Wednesday, we planted 1000 fruit trees, all different kinds, in order for each family to have some source of fresh food on a regular basis. On Wednesday, we helped with a process that would be foreign to most of us. Wednesday, we worked on a process of Declaraciones. This is a process by which those who do not have a birth certificate were able to regularize their status. A total of 65 people had their status regularized which was an extremely good number considering the process, etc... I couldn't help but think... if the process is this tedious and difficult for Dominicans in their own country; I can only imagine the process for Haitians living in DR.

On Thursday we saw approximately 700+ people in our clinic in El Factor. On Friday, we did something similar in a more remote area in the countryside. On Saturday, our last full day, we had a special celebration for special-needs children and adults.

During the course of the mission week, we were able to pray, and practice the works of mercy while taking very seriously the message of Pope Francis' recent encyclical.

I wish to offer a word of thanks to those who sacrificed their time and their money to be part of the mission. I would also like to thank those who made this mission possible through their generosity. During a mission like this, we always receive so much more than we give. So much was accomplished in such a short period of time.

Thanks again to all the many who supported this mission in so many ways, those who shared their talents and skills, and those who shared their resources. We are indeed a blessed parish.

Queridos Feligreses y Amigos de la Ascensión,



Este año, nuestra misión a El Factor en Nagua, fue organizada en la mayor parte por Marisol Reyes y Jonathan Casilla. Hicieron un trabajo estupendo. ¡Gracias a los dos!

Regresamos por un tercer año a la comunidad de El Factor, en las afueras de Nagua, en la costa norte de la República Dominicana. Como misión servimos de acuerdo con las necesidades y deseos de la parroquia anfitriona. Ésta fue una misión maravillosa, todo salió bien y nosotros, junto con la parroquia de San Francisco, pusimos un gran énfasis en la encíclica del Papa Francisco, *Laudato si'*. El lunes, 6 de julio, fuimos a una comunidad pequeña y ayudamos con una campaña de limpieza. Recogimos y cargamos basura, en particular, cosas como bolsas plásticas que le harían daño a lo que podría ser tierra fértil. El martes, nos dividimos en cuatro grupos y entre el martes y el miércoles, sembramos 1,000 árboles frutales, todos de diferentes clases, para que cada familia tuviera alguna clase de alimento fresco regularmente. El miércoles ayudamos con un proceso que sería desconocido para la mayoría de nosotros. El miércoles trabajamos en un proceso de "declaraciones." Éste es un proceso a través del cual aquellos que no tenían un certificado de nacimiento podían regularizar su estatus. Un total de 65 personas pudo regularizar su estatus, el cual fue un número extremadamente bueno considerando el proceso, etc... No pude dejar de pensar... si el proceso es tan difícil y tedioso para los dominicanos en su propio país, solo puedo imaginarme el proceso para haitianos viviendo en la República Dominicana.

El jueves vimos aproximadamente a 700 o más personas en nuestras clínicas en El Factor. El viernes, hicimos algo similar en un área remota en el campo. El sábado, nuestro último día completo, tuvimos una celebración especial para niños y adultos con necesidades especiales.

Durante el curso de la semana de la misión, pudimos orar y practicar obras de caridad mientras tomábamos muy en serio el mensaje de la reciente encíclica del Papa Francisco.

Deseo ofrecer una palabra de gracias a aquellos que sacrificaron su tiempo y su dinero para ser parte de esta misión. También me gustaría dar las gracias a aquellos que hicieron esta misión posible a través de su generosidad. Durante una misión como esta, siempre recibimos mucho más de lo que hemos dado. Se realizó tanto en tan poco tiempo.

Gracias otra vez a todos aquellos que apoyaron esta misión en tantas distintas maneras, aquellos que compartieron sus habilidades y talentos y aquellos que compartieron sus recursos. Somos verdaderamente una parroquia bendecida.


